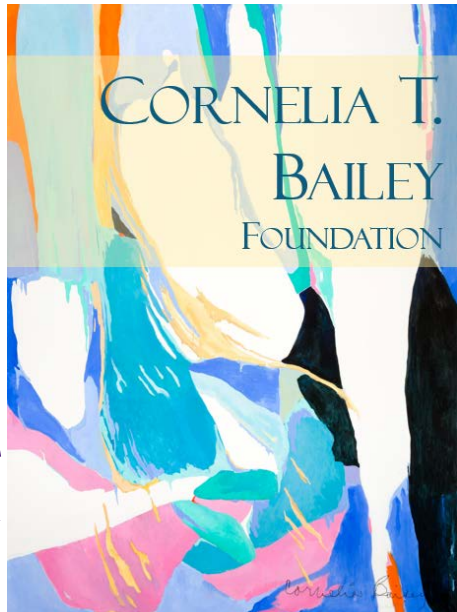

Meet Our Conductors

Jenn Girdlestone started as the director of bands at Boca Raton Community High School in the fall of 2011. She oversees the concert bands, marching band, jazz band, percussion, and color guard.

Jenn Girdlestone attended Florida State University where she graduated magna cum laude with a Bachelor of Music Education and a Bachelor of Music in Horn Performance. While at FSU, she performed in the world-renowned Florida State University Marching Chiefs serving as the Head Drum Major and Horn Section Leader. She also performed in the Symphonic Band, Wind Orchestra, Philharmonia, and Symphony Orchestra. During her college years, she performed as a member of the Boston Crusaders Drum and Bugle Corps for four years, serving the last two years as Mellophone Section Leader and Soloist. She was also a member of the Tau Beta Sigma national honorary band service sorority.

Jenn Girdlestone has a passion for developing student leadership and training the next generation of leaders. She has directed the Marching Band Leadership camp for Palm Beach County's Summer Band Camps and also co-leads the Drum Major session at Penny's Camp in St. Petersburg, FL. Jenn Girdlestone is also a clinical educator and works with college interns to help them make their final preparations to become music educators in their own classrooms.

Jenn Girdlestone also performs with the Orchid City Brass Band on tenor horn and associate conductor, with the Palm Beach Brass Quintet on French horn, and in her church worship band on bass guitar and piano.

Jenn Girdlestone's goal as a music educator is not only to provide the best education and opportunities she can for her students, but also to instill in them a passion for music and an intrinsic desire of furthering one's own potential.



David Gibble is a trumpeter, educator, and composer who freelances throughout South Florida in classical, contemporary, and jazz styles, having performed with the Woody Herman Orchestra and Duffy Jackson's Swingin' New Band to the Palm Beach Opera Orchestra, Florida Wind Symphony, Palm Beach State College Faculty Jazztet and a variety of other ensembles. Mr. Gibble was the former Director of Bands and Music Department Chair at Palm Beach State College in Lake Worth, where he taught for 29 years. He also was a co-founder of the Orchid City Brass Band and served as its conductor from 2012-2018. Currently, he plays Principal Solo Cornet with OCB. Gibble holds a B.S. in Music Education from West Chester University (Pa.) and an M.M. in Jazz Studies from the University of North Texas.



Meet Our Conductors

Adam Delbridge-Smith is a British conductor, brass specialist, and educator based in South Florida. A graduate of the Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester, England, he has built a reputation for developing ensembles of all levels with clarity, energy, and musical integrity.

In the UK, Adam served as Musical Director of Poynton Brass Band, leading the ensemble through a period of significant growth and achieving a podium finish at the North West Brass Band Association Rochdale Contest. His work has included innovative concert programming and collaborations designed to engage both performers and audiences.

Following his move to the United States, Adam has quickly established himself within the South Florida music community, where he has been supported and guided by Gary Green as he built his footing in a new musical landscape. He will begin graduate studies in conducting at the University of Miami - Frost School of Music in Fall 2026, where he will study under Dr. Michael Hancock.



Ryan Ross Originally from Chester, New York, Mr. Ross earned a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from Florida Atlantic University (2013) and a Master's Degree in Music Education from the University of Florida (2019). During his time at FAU, he was an active performer in the Wind Ensemble, Orchestra, Percussion Ensemble, and the FAU Marching Owls. He studied under Dr. Kyle Prescott (conducting) and Warren Gallic, Jeff Kraus, Tony Laverder, Neel Shukla, and Benjamin Charles (percussion). His graduate studies at UF focused on the theory, philosophy, and fundamentals of music education, with a deep dive into music theory, world music, and popular music.

Mr. Ross has been a band director for 11 years, spending his time at L.C. Swain Middle School, and currently Jupiter High School. During his time at L.C. Swain, Mr. Ross resurrected the program, leading them to straight superior for the first time in school history, and expanding the program from 12 returning members, to 150 in 3 short years. As the Band Director of Jupiter High School, Mr. Ross is the director of the award winning Spirit of Jupiter Marching band, Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band and Jazz bands. SOJ is a 19 year state finalist, with 4 State Championships to its name, and under the direction of Mr. Ross, the Wind Symphony was awarded the prestigious Otto Kraushaar award for the first time since 1992, and has received the distinction twice in the last 4 years.
